2010 ALFRED STREET RECONSTRUCTION FROM MICHIGAN AVE. TO POINT EDWARD/SARNIA BOUNDARY

The Village of Point Edward Council is undertaking the detailed design for the reconstruction of Alfred Street from Michigan Ave. to Point Edward/Sarnia boundary. The work is expected to commence in early April, 2010 and be completed by the early June, 2010.

The proposed work includes:

- Construction of a new storm sewer
- Removal of old storm sewer, catch basins and connections
- Road construction consisting of:
 - Removal of existing curb and gutter
 - Excavation
 - Installation of sub-drains
 - 300 mm – granular ‘A’
 - 90 mm – asphalt
 - Construction of new curbs and gutters
 - Construction of concrete driveway approaches
 - Removal and reconstruction of existing concrete sidewalks
 - Adjustment of manholes and catch basins to finished asphalt/gutter grade
 - Restoration with topsoil and sod

The Open House consisted of an informal drop-in centre to provide an opportunity for residents to view plans and ask questions and to provide input for the improvements.

Residents attended the Open House and were able to speak with Council members and Engineer Ken MacKenzie.
