Point Edward Arena Addition and Renovations

The Village of Point Edward Council is undertaking the Point Edward Arena additions and renovations. The work is expected to commence in June, 2009 and be completed by the end of September, 2009.

An overview of the main changes include:

- Addition of three dressing rooms
- Improve existing Dressing Rooms/Washrooms
- Address accessibility issues
- Washrooms on main floor
- Replacement of boards around the ice surface
- New seating
- Electrical Upgrade including alarm system, back-up lighting and generator
- Structural Upgrades
- Figure Skating Coach's Change Room with washrooms
- Figure Skating Storage Area
- New sound system

The Open House consisted of an informal drop-in centre to provide an opportunity for residents to view plans and ask questions and to provide input for the improvements.

Residents attended the Open House and were able to speak with Council members and Architect Peter Cook.
