

# Rules for PXO Crossings in Point Edward

With the installation of the new PXO Crossings in Point Edward, we would like to share some essential rules from the Government of Ontario website.

### Rules for drivers

Drivers, including cyclists, must stop and yield the entire width of the roadway (wait for pedestrians to clear the road) at:

- pedestrian crossovers
- school crossings
- · locations where there is a crossing guard

Only when pedestrians and school crossing guards have crossed and are safely on the sidewalk can drivers and cyclists proceed.



### Pedestrian crossovers

A pedestrian crossover is a crossing that has:

- specific signs
- pavement markings
- · lights

#### Some have:

- · illuminated overhead lights
- warning signs
- pedestrian push buttons

Pedestrian crossover with
pedestrian push buttons, pavement
markings, signs and lights.
