**With the installation of the new PXO Crossings in Point Edward, we would like to share some essential rules from the Government of Ontario website.**

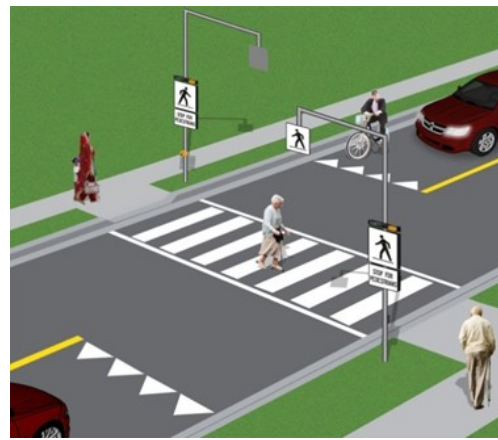

### Rules for drivers

Drivers, including cyclists, must stop and yield the entire width of the roadway (wait for pedestrians to clear the road) at:

- pedestrian crossovers
- school crossings
- locations where there is a crossing guard

Only when pedestrians and school crossing guards have crossed and are safely on the sidewalk can drivers and cyclists proceed.



### Pedestrian crossovers

A pedestrian crossover is a crossing that has:

- specific signs
- pavement markings
- lights

Some have:

- illuminated overhead lights
- warning signs
- pedestrian push buttons

Type of crossover

Pedestrian crossover with pedestrian push buttons, pavement markings, signs and lights.
