



## 2022 Accessibility Plan Review

This is the annual report of activities undertaken by the Village of Point Edward to improve accessibility and implement the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) and the Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation. This report includes action taken in 2021.

The following activities took place in 2021 to improve accessibility for people in the Village of Point Edward:

- Installation of two additional parking spaces for individuals requiring accessible parking at the Point Edward Memorial Arena.
- Installation of one parking space for individuals requiring accessible parking at McCrae Park.
- Procurement of a Jenn Swing to be installed in 2022 for use in Waterfront Park.
- Sponsoring of the installation of a Snoezelen Room at Bridgeview School for use by the students that are medically fragile.
- Approval by Council to establish a Municipal Accessibility Advisory Committee, although not required by regulation, in 2022.
- Sponsorship of the Secret Santa program run by Pathways Health Centre for Children, a local organization that raises funds to support different programs for people with disabilities.

The Multi-Year Accessibility Plan continues to be consulted when making capital and operating decisions in order to ensure compliance.

This report was completed on May 30, 2022 with input from the Executive Assistant and the Operations Manager.
