

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT EDWARD

BY-LAW NUMBER 27 OF 2021

Being a By-law to Authorize the Use of Internet and Telephone Voting for
the 2022 Municipal Election

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O 1996, C32* (The Act) provides that a Council of a local municipality may pass a by-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS subsection 42.(2)(a) of the Act sets out that a by-law passed under subsection 42.(1) applies to a regular election if the by-law is passed on or before May 1 in the year of an election;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Point Edward deems it appropriate to use voting by internet and telephone for the 2022 municipal election;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Point Edward hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the alternative voting methods of "Internet" and "Telephone" are hereby authorized for the purpose of voting during an early voting period, up to and including Election Day, commencing with the municipal election to be held in 2022.
2. That By-law 21 of 2021 hereby be repealed and replaced with this by-law.
3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect as of the date of its passing for implementation in the 2022 municipal election and subsequent elections thereafter.
4. By-Law 21 Of 2021 is hereby repealed upon passing of this By-Law.
