

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT EDWARD

BY-LAW NO. 4 of 2016

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH ONE-THIRD OF THE REMUNERATION PAID
TO ELECTED OFFICIALS BE DEEMED AS EXPENSES**


WHEREAS Section 283(7) of The Municipal Act, 2001 provides that on or after December 1, 2003, a council shall review a by-law under subsection (5) at a public meeting at least once during the four-year period corresponding to the term of office of its members after a regular election;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the Corporation of the Village of Point Edward Council ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT Council hereby deems that one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of the council and its local boards as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of the council or local board.
2. THAT Council remuneration is to be considered an honorarium.
3. THAT the policy relating to provision 1 and attached to this By-law as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.

This By-Law given a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD READING and FINALLY PASSED this 26th day of January, 2016.
