By-Law Number 20 of 2022 Being a By-Law to
Require Maintenance of Privately Owned Hydrants and Valves

WHEREAS there are a number of privately owned fire hydrants and valves in the Village of Point Edward; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Point Edward deems it necessary to have hydrants and valves regularly exercised and maintained; and

WHEREAS it is of utmost importance to have all valves and hydrants operating properly in order to provide effective and safe firefighting capability.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Village of Point Edward requires all privately owned hydrants and valves in the Village of Point Edward be maintained on a yearly basis; and

THAT owners of private hydrants and valves be required to submit documentation to the Village of Point Edward that maintenance has been completed on all private hydrants and valves to ensure the following regulations are met:


- a) The Fire Code
- b) The Building Code Act; and
- c) The National Fire Protection Act (NFPA) – NFPA 24 – Installation of Private Fire Service Mains and Their Appurtenances; and

THAT all information is to be provided to the Point Edward Municipal Office by August 1 of each year.
