CALLS FOR SERVICE BILLING WORKGROUPS



Drugs Includes trafficking, production, and importation of drugs including marihuana, cocaine, heroin, crystal meth or other controlled substances. It also includes occurrences related to indoor/outdoor grow labs.

Drug Possession Includes all occurrences where the most serious violation is possession of marihuana, cocaine, heroin, crystal meth or other controlled substance. It also includes other minor drug related offences.

Operational calls for service are non-criminal events that police attend to. These include animal complaints, non-criminal domestic disturbances, missing persons, noise complaints, property – lost or found, sudden deaths, and assist public calls.

Operational 2 Includes false alarms, keep the peace and 911 calls/911 hang-ups. Due to the higher frequency of these calls, they have been separated out from the 'Operational' category and allocated a lower time standard. Traffic incidents are excluded.

Other Criminal Code Violations The majority of offences counted in the Other Criminal Code Offences group are criminal offences that are not directed to people or related to property. It is similar to the group that Statistics Canada uses when reporting 'Other Criminal Code'. These include prostitution, offensive weapons, bail violations, counterfeiting, disturb the peace, indecent acts, breach of probation, and bribery.

Property Crime Violations This category is similar to the group that Statistics Canada uses when reporting 'Property Crimes'. These include arson, break and enter, theft, possession of stolen goods, mischief, identity theft, and some frauds.

Statutes & Acts Includes provincial statutes, primarily the Mental Health Act, Landlord Tenant Act and Trespass to property offences. It also includes custody dispute calls.

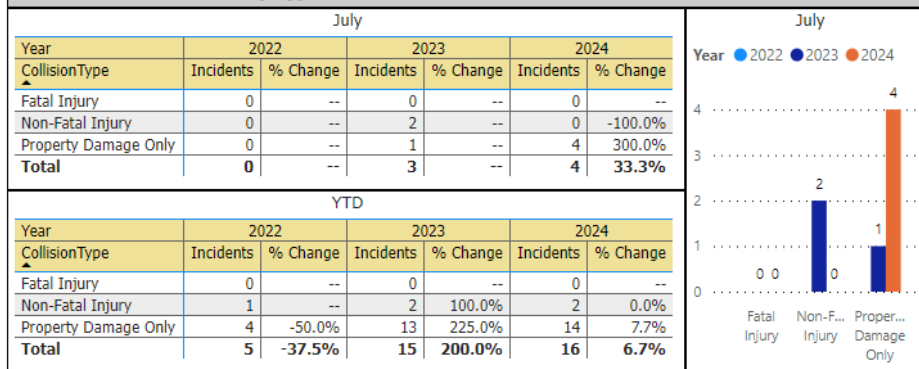
Traffic Includes motor vehicle collisions of all severities (property damage, personal injury and fatalities) and road rage incidents reported to police.

Violent Crimes The majority of offences counted in the Violent Crimes group are crimes against persons. This category is similar to the group that Statistics Canada uses when reporting 'Violent Crimes'. These include homicides, attempted murders, assaults, threats and robberies.

Non-Fatal Overdose Occurrences

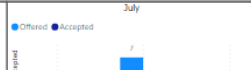




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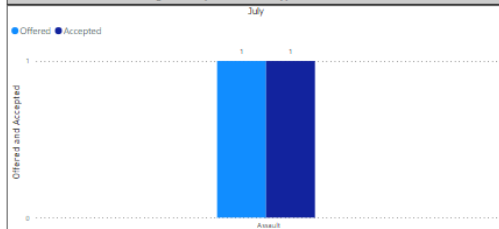

Referrals to Victim Service Agencies by Occurrence Type



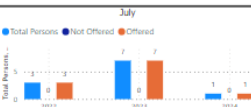

Other News

- The Lambton CSO has been actively building and improving relationships with local, regional, and international news outlets through email correspondence and phone interviews.
- Media release was posted regarding back-to-school safety for drivers and pedestrians.
- The CSO showcased the enforcement efforts of Lambton OPP members in cases of stunt driving and impaired driving offences in July/August.

In September, the CSO has several Fraud, bike safety, internet safety and OPP Kids presentations scheduled. Lambton OPP will be attending 4 Fall Fairs and a Touch-a-Truck in Point Edward.

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS OVERVIEW

During the summer months our School Resource Officers (SRO) were redeployed to the front-line to assist with calls for service.

JULY 2024

Forest- Caller advised that she was with a 13-year-old female whose mother had just wrapped a seatbelt around her arm. Police spoke with the mother who advised she was holding the youth's arm to keep her from jumping out of moving vehicle. CAS notified.

Grand Bend - 16-year-old female reported being sexually assaulted in the water by a 30-year-old male while swimming in Grand Bend. The complainant did not respond to an initial statement request. Suspect identified.

Corunna- Report of a 12-year-old female having a mental health episode and throwing items around outside. Officers attended with the MCRT unit and resolved the situation. MCRT spoke to the young female, her mother, and worker. Extensive resources already in place. Insufficient grounds to proceed with an apprehension.

Corunna – Missing 14-year-old female with concerns surrounding her safety, wellbeing, and intoxication level. Previous MHA apprehension/suicidal remarks. Police located the youth and confirmed that suicidal remarks were made. Female was then apprehended under MHA.

Petrolia – Caller advised that she was at a party in Petrolia and observed the use of cannabis and dab pens. Complainant also stated that a young male was selling "narcotics". Police confirmed that only cannabis products were involved. No proof of offences or persons involved.

Enniskillen – Caller reported her struggles in relation to her 10-year-old daughter. She felt that her daughter had just “released everything”. Complainant had already been in contact with their family physician and since then several referrals had been made. The female was also struggling to control her emotions and could not tolerate minimal stress at times. MCRT engaged, advice and information provided to caller.

Corunna- Report of a female physically attacking other people and causing damage. The youth had attempted to cause harm to a younger sibling and her mother. As a result, she was apprehended and transported to Bluewater Health and placed on a Form 1.

Sombra – Police responded to a report of four youths fighting on the train tracks in Sombra. Police attended and spoke to all youths involved. Police determined the disturbance to be a consensual fight and did not have any safety concerns.

AUGUST 2024

Corunna – Police received multiple calls regarding a 12-year-old female who was being physical, throwing objects, and was threatening self-harm. The youth was apprehended, as a danger to herself, and was transported to BWH where she was placed on Form 1.

Petrolia – Report a female volunteer that had sent explicit photos to other boy volunteers who were minors. Police obtained conversations and learned that the 15-year-old boys were enticing the female to send the photos. Police located all parties and educated them on Snapchat, and internet safety. The female was further cautioned regarding sending these images to minors.

Courtright – Police responded to a call involving a male youth that was walking around with a machete. Officers determined that the complainant was having paranoid delusions. She believed her youngest child was working with her estranged oldest son to sabotage her life. The female was apprehended and transported to BWH where she was placed on a Form 1.

Corunna – Dispute between siblings (youth) fighting over cannabis and cigarettes. One male was in the house damaging property. Police attended and all parties were separated. The parent was contacted and returned home from work. The youth was then taken to the hospital to speak with crisis workers.

For the month of July and August, there were **11** occurrences relating to mental health involving youths ranging from **13-17** years of age.

There were **12** motor vehicle collision occurrences during the month of July and August involving youths **16 and 17** years of age.

Numerous traffic stops were conducted, resulting in **24 youths being warned** and **54 Provincial Offence Notices** given under the Highway Traffic Act. Youths ranged from **16-17 years** of age.

CRIME & TRAFFIC – July/August 2024

AREA CRIME SERGEANT:

- One sudden death/suicide investigated.

CSCU SERGEANT:

- During the months of July and August 2024 Lambton CSCU investigated 16 occurrences.
- Lambton CSCU members laid a total of 27 charges.
- Lambton CSCU wrote 4 warrants for drug trafficking and property crimes investigations. The unit completed 5 warrant service entries.
- Lambton CSCU conducted a drug trafficking investigation and conducted a planned traffic stop arrest. Four parties were arrested and charged with 13 offences. Lambton CSCU conducted the search of the vehicle and persons and located 50 grams of Fentanyl, 28 grams of Cocaine, & 11 grams of Methamphetamine. All charged with Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking. These traffickers were working in Lambton Shores/Kettle & Stony Point First Nation.
- Lambton CSCU conducted a property crime investigation into a Break & Enter that occurred in Lambton Shores. Through the investigation, the location of the stolen property was determined. Lambton CSCU executed a S.487 search warrant. The CSCU was able to recover over 90% of the property valued at approx. \$30,000. Property was returned to the owner. One party was charged with 5 criminal offences, including Break & Enter and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime.
- Lambton CSCU assist Border Enforcement and Security Taskforce (BEST) with physical surveillance and a S.11 CDSA search warrant regarding a drug trafficking investigation in Lambton County.
- Lambton CSCU continues to assist Walpole Island Police Service with enforcement to combat the opioid crisis in that community.
- Lambton CSCU assisted Elgin-Middlesex CSCU & with two S.11 CDSA warrant to search regarding a drug trafficking investigations.
- Lambton CSCU assisted Essex CSCU with a warrant entry and search regarding a drug trafficking investigation.
- Lambton CSCU assisted Biker Enforcement Unit S.11 CDSA search warrant for drug trafficking.
- Lambton CSCU continues to offer support to frontline policing operations by taking samples of seized drugs and sending the samples to Health Canada for analysis.
- Lambton CSCU members continue support staffing of Grand Bend during heightened summer months.

TRAFFIC:

- During this reporting period OPP members conducted sixteen (16) traffic enforcement initiatives
- Twelve (12) PON's were issued
- There were five (5) motor vehicle collisions
- Three (3) RIDE Programs were conducted
- Zero (0) Impaired Drivers were arrested.

CITIZENS SELF REPORTING:

You have the option to report select occurrences to the OPP from your computer or mobile device using the OPP's [Citizen Self Reporting](#) system.

Use this system to report:

1. Lost/missing property under \$5,000

2. Stolen license plates or validation stickers
3. Theft from a vehicle under \$5,000
4. Mischief/damage to a vehicle under \$5,000
5. Mischief/damage to property (other than a vehicle) under \$5,000
6. Theft under \$5,000
7. Driving Complaint

FRONTLINE SUPPORT UNIT (FSU):

The Frontline Support Unit (FSU) program is a differential response strategy that focuses on call management. This includes responsibility for the OPP's Citizen Self-Reporting (CSR) system which is an online police reporting system for members of the public to report specific occurrences directly to the OPP via the Internet. The FSU model will offer a call handling alternative for select calls for service allowing the deployment of resources to critical incidents or member engagement in proactive police activities. Through the use of technology, the OPP continues to improve our processes and service delivery in support of its vision.
