## ELECTION DAY: OCTOBER 22, 2018

The 2018 Municipal and School Board Elections are fast approaching. The Village of Point Edward wants to ensure all voters are given every opportunity to vote and to ensure that the voting process is as accessible and accountable as possible.

Eligible voters can vote using a computer, telephone, cell phone, laptop, iPad, or tablet.



### Public Information Sessions

The Village of Point Edward will be hosting two Public Information Sessions on **Wednesday, September 26, 2018** regarding Internet and Telephone Voting in the 2018 Municipal Election. The first session will take place from **10 a.m. – 11 a.m.** and the second will be held from **7 p.m. – 8 p.m.** Both information sessions will be held at the Municipal Office: 135 Kendall St., Point Edward.

### Voter Information Letters

**Voter Information Letters (VIL)** will be sent out in the mail prior to September 25, 2018. The letters will provide voters with a unique PIN number that is assigned to, and may only be used by, the elector identified in the letter. If you have *not* received your VIL by October 1, 2018, please contact the Municipal Office at (519) 337-3021.

If you do not have access to a device to vote online or to a telephone, or if you require assistance, you may visit a help centre at the locations and times outlined below. **Please bring your VIL with you if you come for voting assistance.**
