



## PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION

Modifications are being made to Michigan Avenue throughout the Village of Point Edward in order to provide for traffic calming measures and a clearer outline of how Michigan Avenue is to be used.

This will be achieved by implementing a road diet strategy between Christina Street and Front Street. This includes the relining of the road to indicate bike lanes both east and west bound, one lane of traffic in each direction, and a turning lane in the center, where appropriate.

From Front Street west to Livingston Street there will be clear line markings installed to indicate parking lanes along each side of the road and a single lane of traffic in each direction. There will also be some turning lanes indicated where necessary.

These modifications are being implemented to make travel safer for all those using Michigan Avenue.

At the meeting there will also be an opportunity for the public to comment on the potential installation of four way stops at the intersections listed below:

- Alfred Street at Ernest Street
- Louisa Street at Charles Street
- Albert Street at Alexandra Avenue

Also being considered are stop signs on Victoria Avenue at St. Clair Street in both directions.

The meeting will be held at the Community Hall at 210 Monk Street on Tuesday, June 4, 2019, between 7:00 and 8:00 pm.
