New Vaccine Call Centre

To increase call capacity and improve access to vaccine information, Lambton Public Health (LPH) has created a dedicated Vaccine Call Centre, which will run from Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Individuals with COVID-19 vaccine inquiries are asked to call **226-254-8222**. Expanded Booking Eligibility for Vaccination Appointments

Beginning Thursday, May 6, 2021, at 8:00 a.m., the following groups throughout the province will be eligible to book a COVID-19 vaccine appointment through the provincial online booking system and call centre or directly through public health units:

- Individuals turning 50 and over in 2021;
- Individuals with high-risk health conditions;
- People who cannot work from home who fall under Group One (including remaining elementary and secondary school workers); and
- First Nations, Inuit and Métis individuals in addition to the other channels previously available to book their appointment.
